MARINE POLISH (siliconless)

CHARACTERISTICS: MARINE POLISH is a liquid, universal polishing material for lightly oxidized polyester or polyurethane surfaces and achieves a glossy surface.

USE: Cleans light corrosion and weathering damage, polishes plastic surfaces.

APPLICATION: Shake MARINE POLISH well before use. The surface must first be cleaned of coarse, abrasive dirt particles as these could damage the surface. MARINE POLISH should be applied over approximately with a moistened lint-free cloth and then polished by soft cloth in a circular motion until a glossy surface is obtained. Process 0.5 m² areas one by one.

MARINE POLISH can also be applied by polishing machine or lamb fur discs. To give a long-lasting seal to the polished surface coat it with MARINE WAX.

PRECAUTIONS: Directions for using the product are available in the enclosed safety booklet and in the corresponding technical leaflets of the Professional Cooperative of the Chemical Industry.
