MARINE WAX

CHARACTERISTICS: MARINE WAX is a liquid sealing emulsion based on Carnauba wax. It contains silicone in pure form for long-life and UV protection. Furthermore, MARINE WAX contains very fine abrasive components.

USE: For the long-term preservation of varnish, metal, hard-plastic and gelcoat surfaces etc.

PRODUCT DATA:

Colour: beige (liquid dispersion)

Specific weight: 0.93 g/ml at 20°C

Flash point: >100°C

APPLICATION: The surfaces to be sealed should be cleaned and polished with MARINE RUBBING or MARINE POLISH. Apply MARINE WAX generously with a sponge or a soft cloth in a circular motion on the cleaned surface. Let is set for several minutes then polish the liquid wax manually without pressure with a soft, dry and clean cotton cloth. The sealant shouldn't be applied with a polishing machine. MARINE WAX can easily be polished even after the liquid wax has dried.

PRECAUTIONS: Directions for using the product are available in the enclosed safety booklet and in the corresponding technical leaflets of the Professional Cooperative of the Chemical Industry. These directions serve only as technical instructions. They are compiled based on experience. They, however, have no binding or legal character.
